



TOURNAMENT OF BANDS ALL-STAR MARCHING BAND – MORE NOTES, REMINDERS, ETC . . .



1. ARRIVAL AT CCVT – check address on all information. There are 2 schools. We are at the school in Sicklerville on Cross Key Road. Park out back – early arrivals will not be admitted to campus until school clears. PLEASE do not interfere with school traffic!
2. REHEARSAL – dress for inside/outside rehearsal space, water/snack as needed for your afternoon. Please stop for your lunch prior to arrival at the school.
3. BYOC – bring your own cymbals. BYOR – bring your own rifle. BYOB – bring your own baton.
4. EAR/HEARING PROTECTION – if you use it, bring it and use it for rehearsals.
5. MEDICATION – you are responsible for your own medication.
6. DINNER – this is provided. The menu is listed in your 11.10.19 information. If you require alternate food items, please bring along. A microwave will be available if needed. Note – there will be peanut butter/bread available.
7. LODGING – all student rooms are assigned and registered at hotel. Rooms are assigned based on your school and section. There are 4 students per room. There is no option to change rooms.
8. HOTEL CHECK-IN – you will have a room key. Don't lose it. At check-in you may pick up snacks and water for your room. Do NOT order out for delivery. You will not get your food.
9. PARADE ATTIRE – you are required to have solid black pants, socks and shoes. Band uniform jacket. Auxiliary tunics supplied. Please read details in 11.10.19 information.
10. LAYERS - for the parade – it may be cold, warm or frigid. Over the past 10 parades we have experienced 60+ degrees to 20 degrees with freezing winds.
NOTE: we will continue to check weather up until Tuesday, 11.26.19 – you can too!
11. GLOVES – auxiliary should have nude/tan gloves if you wear gloves. Musicians should wear black/white depending on your band uniform gloves.
12. PARENT/FAN VIEWING – links on our website have numerous options for parade fans including route, viewing areas, and additional activities.
13. PHOTOS – we do many photos and most are posted on TOB facebook page.
14. VIDEO – 2019 TOB ASMB video will be produced and available to all members/families.
