



TOURNAMENT OF BANDS ALL-STAR MARCHING BAND 11.18.19 NOTES, REMINDERS, ETC . . .

1. ARRIVAL AT CCVT – do NOT arrive on campus until after 1:00 PM. School dismisses at 12:40 – do not interfere with their dismissal.
2. BE PREPARED – you are expected to have all your music memorized prior to your arrival. Your auxiliary work must be memorized as well. Our rehearsal time is limited and is to coordinate all sections, not to teach you individually.
3. QUESTIONS – contact your section head – they have emailed you with information as well.
4. REHEARSAL ATTIRE – dress for inside/outside rehearsal space, water/snack as needed for your afternoon. Please stop and eat your lunch prior to arrival at the school.
5. AUXILIARY – bring your own roll of white electrical/vinyl tape to speed up the process of taping flags to poles.
6. BYOC – bring your own cymbals. BYOR – bring your own rifle. BYOB – bring your own baton.
7. WIND INSTRUMENTS – piccolo(no flute), Bb Clarinet(no bass clarinet), Marching Baritone(no concert baritone), Marching FHorn/Mellophone(no concert horn), Marching Tuba(on your shoulder) – this is what you signed up for!
8. EAR/HEARING PROTECTION – if you use it, bring it and use it for rehearsals.
9. MEDICATION – you are responsible for your own medication.
10. DINNER – this is provided. The menu is listed in your 11.10.19 information. If you require alternate food items, please bring along. A microwave will be available if needed. Note – there will be peanut butter/bread available.
11. LODGING – 4 students per room. There is no option to change rooms.
12. HOTEL CHECK-IN – you will have a room key. Don't lose it. At check-in you may pick up snacks and water for your room. Do NOT order out for delivery. You will not get your food.
13. PARADE ATTIRE – you are required to have solid black pants, socks and shoes. Band uniform jacket. Auxiliary tunics supplied. Please read details in 11.10.19 information.
14. GLOVES – auxiliary should have nude/tan gloves if you wear gloves. Musicians should wear black/white depending on your band uniform gloves.
15. LAYERS - for the parade – it may be cold, warm or frigid.
NOTE: we will continue to check weather up until Tuesday, 11.26.19 – you can too!
16. PARENT/FAN VIEWING – links on our website have numerous options for parade fans including route, viewing areas, and additional activities.
17. PHOTOS – we do many photos and most are posted on TOB facebook page.
18. VIDEO – 2019 TOB ASMB video will be produced and available to all members/families.
