what to do with your video for your TIA 2021 VIRTUAL! event

COPYRIGHT: Tournament requires all participating groups to comply with copyright and recording laws regarding performance and/or use of arrangements of copyrighted music, recorded music, visual images and other materials, as well as the use of copyrighted audio, spoken text and display of copyrighted words and images.

RECORD YOUR VIDEO – use the recording setting on your device to create your performance video. This must be an mp4 format for uploading.

Every device will be different. Refer to your device user guide and help menu for best results. You may want to experiment with several different settings to create the best possible video/audio quality.

Suggestions:

1. Mount/stabilize device with a stand/tripod
2. Isolate device from people, fans, staff, extra noise
3. Start video with performance, no introduction needed
4. End video with final note/movement, no exit needed
5. Limit video to under 7:00 minutes

RESTRICTIONS –2021 VIRTUAL! has no restrictions for video recording, editing or camera views.

SHARE YOUR VIDEO IN ZOOM – TIA Unit Director will play the performance video for your TIA 2021 VIRTUAL! event. We suggest both director and additional staff members have video on desktop to play.

ZOOM PRACTICE – Please take some time and share screen, prepare/practice opening, playing, pausing your video prior to your TIA 2021 VIRTUAL! event.
