



# TIA 2021 VIRTUAL!

Open to all Tournament members with TIA Unit Director submission  
Dates: Saturday, March 6 through Saturday, May 1, 2021

**COST:** \$85 payable via credit card to complete registration. Fee is non-refundable.

**PERFORMANCE:** 7:00 minute maximum video performance.  
Each session will close at 20:00 minutes.

**PROCEDURE:** Director registration via on-line form with credit card payment.

**NOTE:** Director must use email address to register.  
Registration closes each week by Sunday at 6:00 PM.  
Events are scheduled for Saturday evening.

**REVIEW:** Panel of 2 NJA Educators/Adjudicators will review performance with live commentary via zoom with Band/Unit Director and 3 staff members.  
Critique: 5 minute critique will follow the performance for discussion.

**SATURDAY:** Zoom session times are scheduled for each registered performance.  
Director will have a schedule for zoom log in to a waiting room, then NJA staff will open block for performance and critique. TIA Directors will share their performance video for critique.  
TIA 2021 VIRTUAL! session will close at 20:00 minutes.

**CRITERIA:** Use of TIA 2021 Placemat as outline for commentary.

Band/Unit Directors should take time and run several practice zoom sessions with staff to prepare for the TIA 2021 VIRTUAL! experience.
